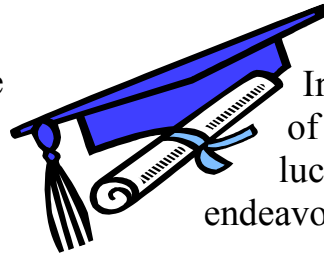

Use of Off-Highway Vehicles on Village Property

It has been brought to our attention by various residents that there is concern regarding off-highway vehicles being driven carelessly and unsupervised, causing concern for others near by. The Village of Irma administration has contacted the Wainwright RCMP detachment regarding the use of ATV's being used on village property.

It is for the safety of our community that we ask everyone to use the off-highway vehicles on their own private property. It is also important to remember that if you are found on public property your ATV must be registered and licensed, as regulated by the provincial law:

“Minimum driving age: The minimum age for operating off-highway vehicles on public land or highways is 14 years where permitted. If you are younger than 14 years, you may operate on public land with supervision by someone 18 years of age or older who is either on the same off-highway vehicle or in close proximity.” (Off-Highway Vehicle Regulation, Section 2.)

As mention above the RCMP have been notified and will be keeping an eye on our Village to correct this issue.
